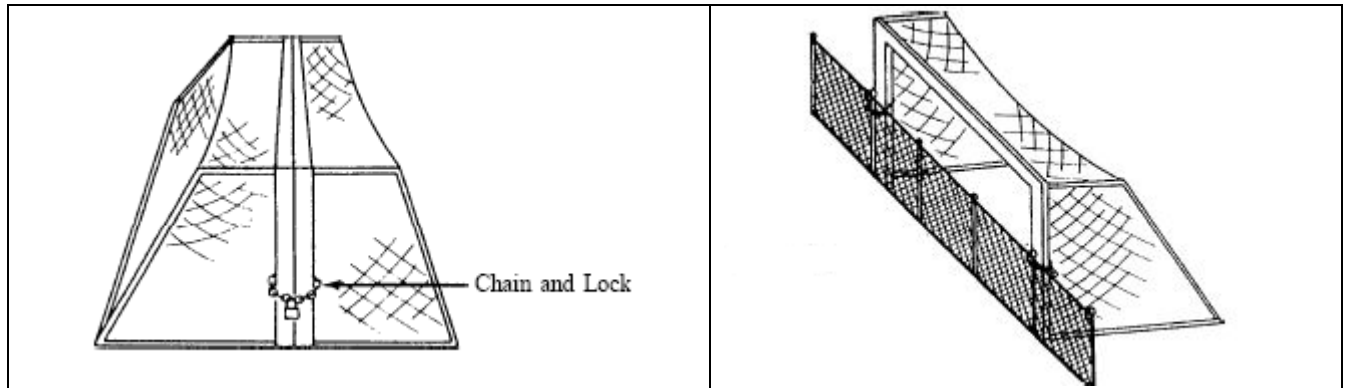


# Instruction for Storing Goals and Corner Flags

## Why Goals Must be Locked

According to CYSA-N, accidents related to the goals accounts for the largest percentage of insurance claims. Goal related accidents does not happen just during the games. All teams must make sure that the goals are stored properly after each practice. Goals must be stored to minimize the possibility of some one playing with them. They need to be stored in either of the following ways.



Goals must be stored upright. Putting the goals face down could break the joints and increase the potential for accidents.



After you unlock the goals for use, lock back the chain and lock, so they do not disappear when you come back to lock the goals. Lock the storage box, too.
